One comment she made to me about her chemotherapy was that she got cold while she lay there waiting for the day's therapy to be over. In her words she "was cold to the bone."

Victoria's Quilts® was born April 1, 1998.
I accept this ministry with a humble heart.*

Victoria's Quilts® is a non-profit 501(c)3 public charity that donates handmade quilts to cancer patients and treatment centers. These quilts will hopefully help the cancer patient feel **"Just a Little Warmer and a Little More Comfortable®."**

The quilts are made by volunteer quilters throughout the U.S. and are then gifted to a specific cancer patient, a treatment facility within the quilter's community or a cancer patient on the Victoria's Quilts® National Recipient Registry.

To begin, contact us and we will send you a Victoria's Quilts® label to sew on the first quilt you send to us. This first quilt must be sent directly to the Home Office for quality control purposes and will not be returned. It is our belief that all subsequent quilts will be made as well as the first quilt. All quilts sent to cancer patients in the name of Victoria's Quilts® must have a Victoria's Quilts® label sewn on the back. These labels will be provided to you at no charge.

The approximate sizes for our quilts are: 36"x36" for baby quilts; 42"x42" for young children's quilts; teen and adult quilts are approximately 50"x60", but no larger than 60"x70".

We would also like to know if we can call on you to make quilts if there is an urgent request in your state. It is our goal to have at least one quilter in each of the 50 states. Victoria's Quilts® "Circle of Friends" spans the USA. If **every** quilter donated just one quilt, we would be well on the way to comforting so many more cancer patients.

- ♥ New, clean, 100% cotton fabric, design-appropriate for men, women, teens, young children and/or babies in pieces at least one yard in length. (Please no previously used or laundered fabric)
- ♥ New, clean 100% cotton flannel, patterned or solid in pieces at least one yard in length (Please no previously used or laundered fabric)
- ♥ Please use on the the U.S. Postal Service for shipping or mailing. All items should be sent to the Home Office address listed above.
- ♥ To make monetary contributions, please send it directly to the Home Office. Any quilter receiving a monetary donation for VQ must send it to the Home Office for processing through the Victoria's Quilts® Accounting System.
